RMP suggested an innovative solution of optics, including high performance floodlights designed to utilise existing columns and work around the wider-than-average pitch.

Our choice of floodlights deliver 65° asymmetrical light distribution from 264 LEDs, with an IP66 and impact strength of IK08.

This project design is ideal for sports fields and stadium / area lighting, with low flicker operations (<1%) suitable for HDTV broadcasting, using 4000K LED with a 70 min colour rendering.
